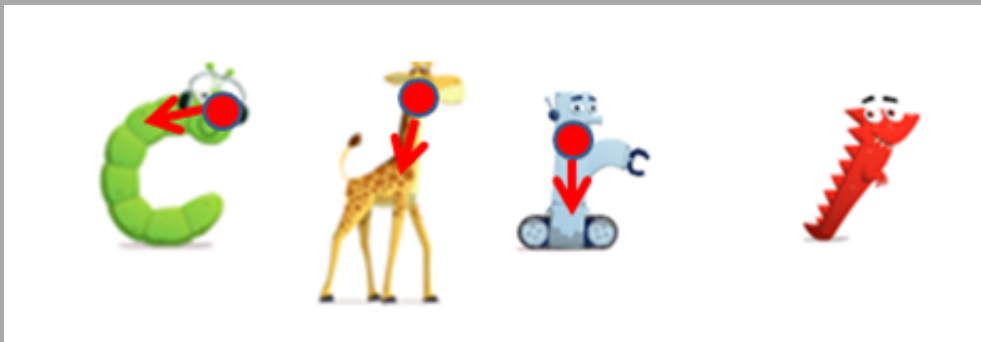

We are focusing on the main four handwriting actions.

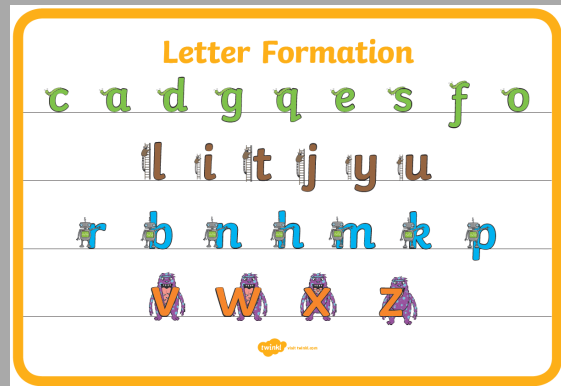
