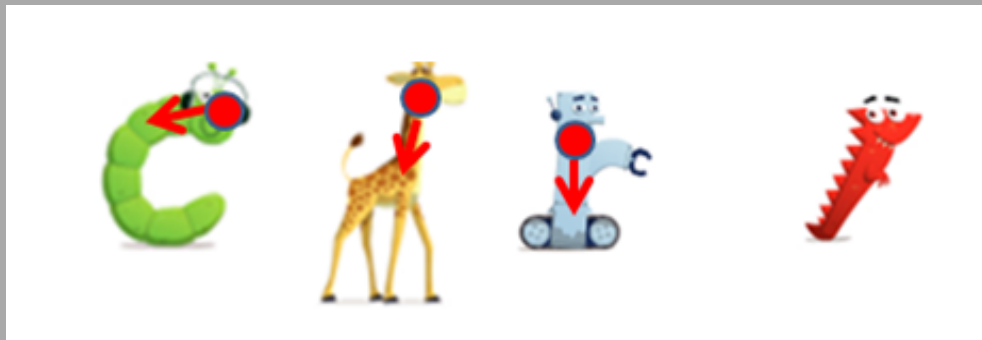
Our Learning Objective:

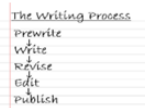
Our Learning Objectives:
