Let's quickly recap what a sentence is.

## What is a sentence?

- A sentence is a group of words that are put together to mean something.
- It starts with a capital letter.
- It ends with a full stop.
- It has finger spaces between the different words.

Which looks like a sentence?

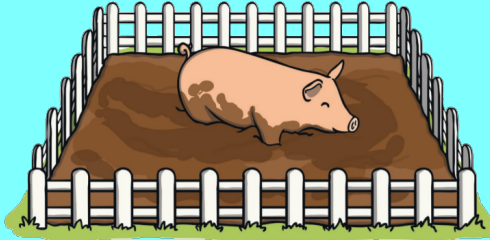
Itisawetdog.

We always need to remember put finger spaces between our words.

# Let's write a sentence for this picture!

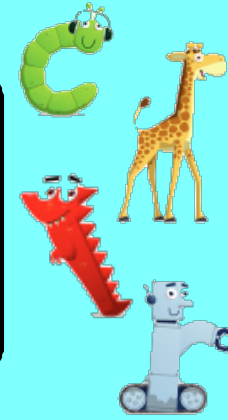


First say our sentence out loud.

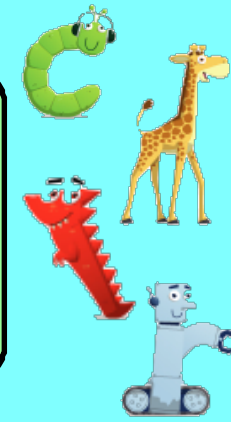
