Try these tricky problems...

There are 23 children in Class 3 and 3 adults.

There are 24 children in Class 4 and 4 adults.

They all went on class trip to Disney land!

How many tickets do they need to buy?

If each ticket costs £1.10, how much would all the tickets cost?

Mrs Hoyle went to the zoo. She found out that the monkeys eat 37 bananas a day and the hippos eat 88 watermelons.

How much fruit do they eat altogether?

The elephants eat double the amount of the hippos. How many watermelons do they eat?

Thomas had £1. He bought a toy for 43p and a drink for 28p. How much did he spend?

How much change did Thomas get from his £1?

Mr Morgan was delivering letters. His first journey was 28 miles. Then he travelled 33 miles and finally he travelled 26 miles. How many miles did Mr Morgan travel?

The next day he travelled 20 more miles. How many did he travel that day?
