- Use of school and Lineham Farm mini bus.

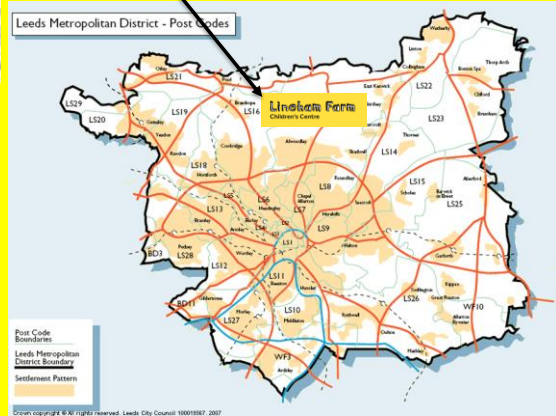
### Payment?

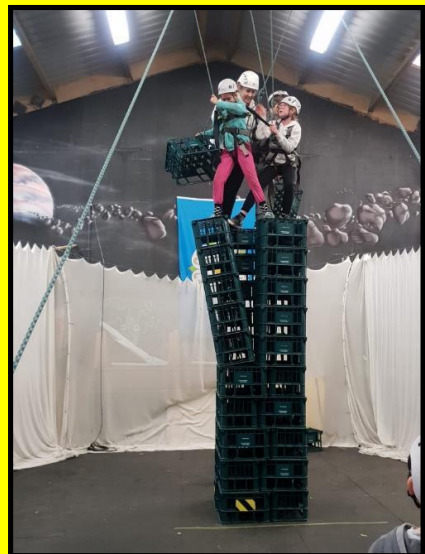
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# CRATE STACK

A climbing challenge which encourages teamwork as children and young people work together to build a high tower to balance on.



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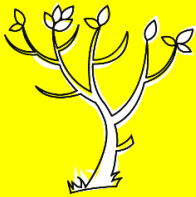

The country trail looks at map reading, having fun in the countryside, the country code, walking and wildlife spotting.

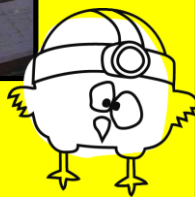
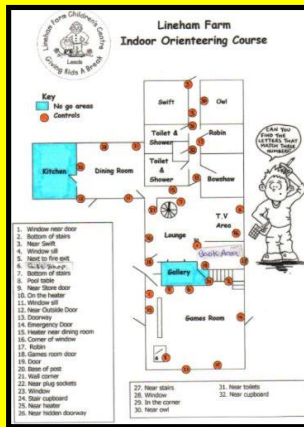


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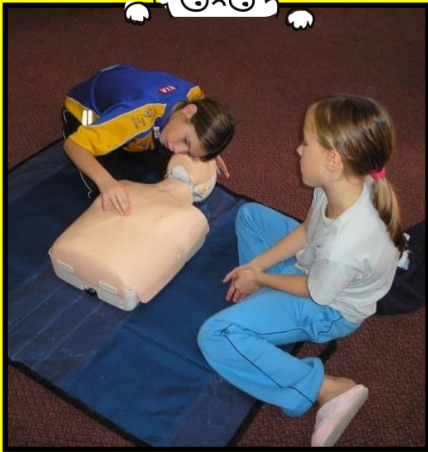


# ORIENTEERING

We tell children to always do as adults tell them - straight away

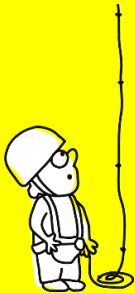




# Lineham Farm - A Child Friendly Environment
