What do these terms mean?

1. Ascending
2. Descending

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Before you start, what do these symbols mean?

$<$  this means lesser than.

For example,  $4 < 5$

$>$  this means greater than.

For example,  $5 > 4$

$=$  this means equal to.

For example,  $4 = 4$

1. Ascending means increasing
2. Descending means decreasing
