| Science | Draw and label 5 magnets you use in everyday life. | Test materials in your home and determine whether they are magnetic. | Carry out and write an investigation involving magnets. |
| History | Create your own timeline to show key events during the Viking era. | Research Viking battle tactics. | Create your own storybook about the events of Stamford Bridge in 1066. |
| Geography | Label a map of the UK to show where the Viking army travelled during the events of Stamford Bridge in 1066. | Look on a map of a country that the Vikings invaded and create a sketch map of your chosen country. | Compare the physical characteristics of Stamford and Hastings. Consider the implications this would have had on the battles. |
| Art/DT | Create your own Viking helmet. | Design your own Viking house. | Use recycled materials to create a monastery, that the Vikings could have pillaged. |
