The Summer Reading Challenge is a national scheme which encourages children aged 4 -11 to enjoy the benefits of reading for pleasure and prevent the summer reading `dip'.

This year's Summer Reading Challenge theme is 'Marvellous Makers' and it's all about creativity! From dance to drawing, junk modelling to music, there's something for everyone.

- The Summer Reading Challenge launches in all Leeds Libraries on **6th July** but children can join at any point throughout the summer holiday until **14th September**.
- Children will receive a starter pack and are encouraged to read up to six books with a prize for every book they read, including a medal at the end!
- Children can read any book they want from thousands of fictional stories, information books on popular topics, graphic novels, and comics, as well as eBooks and eAudio books. Our collections include books that are dyslexia-friendly and suitable for reluctant readers.
- Our Libraries are all **FREE** It's free to join, free to borrow books and no charges for the late return of books.
