- The payment link expires at 12:00pm (lunchtime) on Friday 27th September. Unfortunately, no payments can be accepted after this time.
- Finally, parents need to complete the bottom of the wish list with the reference number and the book(s) purchased then pupils **must return the wish list to school** where the purchase will be verified and the book sent home.
- If copies of popular books run out, then these will be ordered by school through Scholastic and there will be a short delay in you receiving the book(s) purchased for your child.

Don't forget that every book you buy helps us to get FREE BOOKS for our school library. Due to the fantastic support from parents for previous fairs, we have managed to buy new books totalling over £2,000 for our children.
