



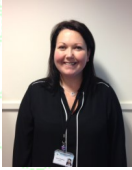

English

This term we will be focusing on a variety of text types including the diary of Samuel Pepys and information texts all about the great fire of London to produce our own diary entry and historical narrative based around the event. We will continue to practise our phonics and reading fluency but now begin to focus on our comprehension skills and understanding of what we are

Maths

In Maths this term we are focusing on addition and subtraction to and within 100. With a focus on using instant recall for our number bonds to 10 and 20. We encourage the children to explain and reason how they got their answers and work on problem solving tasks to deepen their knowledge of Maths.

Reading

Please encourage your child to read at least three times a week at home, for at least 15 minutes each time. We will be sending reading records home again for you to comment on your child's reading.

Naming and locating the worlds 7 continents and 5 oceans. Naming the four countries of the UK, their capital cities and surrounding seas.

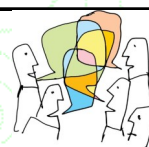
