This term we will be reading a variety of narratives based around the great fire of London the to produce our own newspaper report and descriptive narrative of the event.

We will continue to practise reading fluency but will now have a greater focus on our comprehension skills and understanding of what we are reading.

Maths

To use world maps and atlas' to locate the continents, oceans, four countries of the UK, their capital cities and their surrounding seas.

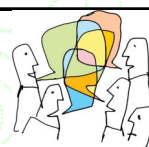
